Reading Fair (Storyboard display) details for students entering 1st grade & 3rd grade:

- Students may hold or wear items that coordinate with the project.
- To dress up your storyboard, you may use: glitter, feathers, pebbles, tinfoil, plastic toys, photographs, beads, ribbons, colored pencils, markers, crayons, colored paper, stencils, and other art supplies.
- Please help your child to be creative and enjoy the project.
- We will have a Reading Fair at school where all the projects will be displayed.
- The project is due the second Friday of the new school year.
