PROBATIONARY CAMBRIDGE LOWER SECONDARY FOR 6TH GRADERS

IMPORTANT:

Students that meet the testing, grades, attendance, and behavior qualifications will be placed into the Cambridge Lower Secondary program on a probationary basis while in 6th grade. Students must keep a B average (3.0) in their core classes and hold to the Cambridge behavior and work ethic standards that are part of our Abundant Life Christian Academy Cambridge Program Contract.

If a student struggles with success while in the program, parents will be notified. Students that are not able to be successful will be removed from the program at the discretion of the coordinator and administration and placed into appropriate level classes. Students successful during their 6th grade year will be invited to continue in the program in 7th grade via a letter home at the end of their 6th grade school year.

Please note that students placed in Cambridge in 6th grade are not guaranteed to continue in the program in 7th and 8th unless they meet the above criteria. If your child is to be removed from the program at any point, you will be notified.
